The organizing committee of the 6th National Colloquium on Evidence Based and Integrative Medicine for Lymphatic Filariasis and other Chronic Dermatoses cordially invite you to the inaugural function at 5.00 pm on the 8th December 2013 at IAD Junction, Uliyathadka, Madhur Road, Kasaragod.

The 6<sup>th</sup> national colloquium has focus on integrative medicine practice and advanced research to explore evidence. Lymphatic Filariasis (LF) is transmitted by mosquito and caused by a worm like parasite. Common presentation of the disease is lower limb lymphoedema and hydrocoele of testes and odema of scrotum. The disease causes deformity of affected limbs affecting the health related quality of life of patients. The WHO classifies LF as 'a neglected disease of the poor'. The treatment for this has received low priority from the Governments and pharmaceutical industry. Global Programme for Elimination of Lymphatic Filariasis (GPELF) was formed by 78 nations which are endemic to the disease. Its morbidity control programme is currently focusing on the simple programs to be delivered to the masses. During the half time review of GPELF held at Seoul, during 2010 integrative treatment of IAD for LF was discussed.

The main focus of the 6th national colloquium is priority setting for future research on lymphoedema due to LF and integrative medicine. Already over 100 research questions were uploaded to [www.indiandermatology.org](http://www.indiandermatology.org) by doctors, paramedical workers, therapists and scientists.

Patients have tried several treatments for long and they are able to judge the benefits of these treatments. They have thoughts on which treatments should be evaluated or modified. Therefore priority setting meeting also invites patients to participate in the discussion. A free LF medical camp is organized on 9, 10 and 11 December 2013 at 8 AM to 9.30 AM as part of the colloquium.
